Summer Camp – The only transactions to be done in July are an anticipated refund for overcharge from La Quinta hotel and then release of reserved summer camp funds in passbook accounts. In the Fall we will receive a \$40 refund from Northeast Georgia Area Council for overpayment of summer camp fees.
